Today, it represents more than 700 different workshops employing over 2,400 artisans. The group aims to keep overhead costs low, to share responsibilities so more income can stay in the hands of the artisans, and to explore new markets.

Intercrafts offers its members such benefits as health care, loan funds and advances, school supplies and books, training programs and technical assistance. Since 2002, the export arm of CIAP has been known as Intercrafts Peru. Intercrafts Peru empowers artisans with full participation in organizational decisions.
