Dominion Traders

Dominion Traders is a family business that works with disadvantaged artisans creating stone and shesham wood crafts. In a society that is strictly divided along religious lines, Dominion Traders hires people regardless of religion or ethnicity, as well as disabled individuals and Afghani refugees. All work together in friendly and cordial relationships. Dominion Traders operates its own workshop, employing more than 55 employees, and also works with some 20 other independently owned workshops. Almost all artisans have chosen to be paid by the piece, but they also participate in profit-sharing, pension plans and medical benefits. Dominion Traders provides interest-free loans and advances to artisans who repay when they can.
