Founded in 1999 with the goal of re-connecting consumers with farmers in a sustainable manner, La Siembra Co-operative produces Fair Trade Certified and Certified Organic Cocoa Camino products. The group's mission is to offer high-quality Fair Trade Certified Organic chocolate, cocoa and sugar products that improve the livelihoods of family farmers and communities at home and abroad. As a worker co-operative, La Siembra chooses to identify with its producer partners by adopting the same democratic, participatory and transparent model their own co-operatives follow. The name La Siembra means "sowing" or "planting time" in Spanish. It is also a symbol for the seeds of change that the co-operative is sowing through its Fair Trade, co-operative and community outreach activities.
