About the Artisans

Mitra Bali

Yayasan Mitra Bali is an artisan cooperative formed to help independent craftspeople find new markets outside of Bali. The cooperative works only with producers who emphasize gender equality, provide safe working conditions, use environmentally sustainable raw materials, and do not exploit women or children. Since many of their crafts are made of wood, Mitra Bali supports reforestation by supplying artisans with softwood tree seedlings.

Snow Owl Salt & Pepper Shakers

A sprinkle here, a dash there. These small ceramic owl salt and pepper shakers add a touch of whimsy to the table. The set is handcrafted From the Mitra Bali artisan group, which ensures that local makers actually receive fair payment, rather than seeing most of their profits go to middlemen, a common problem in the country where tourism flourishes. Mitra Bali producers always receive 50 per cent of total payment up front and are paid promptly.
